## IN SUPPORT OF THE USC TROJAN COUNCIL

BE IT ENACTED BY THE 2019-2020 USC STAFF ASSEMBLY OF THE UNIVERSITY OF SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA.

WHEREAS, the University of Southern California community includes staff, faculty, and students, all of whom share many of the same values, interests, and concerns.

WHEREAS, the presidents of the Staff Assembly, Academic Senate, Undergraduate Student Government, and Graduate Student Government of the University of Southern California established the USC Trojan Council in 2017 and seek to formalize support from their respective organizations.

WHEREAS, the charge of the USC Trojan Council as of September 26, 2019 is the following:

The Trojan Council brings together the Presidents and Vice-Presidents of the Academic Senate, Staff Assembly, Undergraduate and Graduate Student governments of the University of Southern California to discuss and make recommendations regarding issues of common concern. The council meets approximately monthly. It has no independent budget. The Trojan Council currently organizes one university wide open "University Forum" each semester, to which it invites members of the USC administration, including the President, Provost, Vice President of Student Affairs and Senior Vice President of Human Resources. The forum enables all faculty, staff, and students to raise their concerns, to hear from other members of the USC community, and to work toward our shared goals.

Therefore, BE IT RESOLVED, that the USC Staff Assembly supports the establishment of the USC Trojan Council and seeks to support its charge.
